CHILD CARE SUBSIDY: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Child Care Subsidy (CCS) is a government subsidy offered to eligible families as a reduction on fees. Applications for the CCS are made through your Centrelink online account through myGov. Please apply / update details for CCS if you haven't already done so. For more information on this process, visit education.gov.au/childcare

PLEASE NOTE: If children have a break between care of more than eight weeks (e.g. during the school term) their enrolment will be ceased. The Service will update enrolment details with Centrelink. It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to check their child's enrolment status (notifications) in their myGov account and confirm enrolment details where necessary to access CCS.

Program Information:

Thursday 20th December: we will be in centre today doing various Christmas themed crafts while listening to Christmas music and will end the day with a Christmas movie.

Friday 21st December: an in centre day where we will be having a Christmas Party with games, music and dancing, crafts, baking and a movie...all Christmas themed!

Wednesday 2nd January: We will be spending the morning swimming at the pool then across to Connell Park where the children will have their lunch and a play on the park with some games on the oval. Please pack a rash shirt (long sleeve desired), swimmers, a towel, hat, water bottle, lunchbox and your own preferred sunscreen if not using the one provided.

Thursday 3rd January: we will be in centre having a Mexican fiesta. The children will be making tacos and churros, there will be Mexican themed crafts, games (such as pin the tail on the donkey) and a piñata! Lunch and afternoon tea provided.

Friday 4th January: Water play day in centre, children may bring their own water pistols, a limited number will be provided for sharing. We will also have a slip n slide. Please pack along with the usual things: swimmers, towel, hat and your own preferred sunscreen if not using the one provided.

Monday 7th January: off to Nambucca Cinemas today to see "Ralph breaks the internet" (Wreck it Ralph 2) with popcorn and a drink included in the price. Then over to Bellwood Park for lunch and a play at the park.

Tuesday 8th January: commuting by walk to the Bellingen Library for craft activities. The remainder of the day will be in centre, children may bring their own devices.

Wednesday 9th January: Cut up the ice at The Big Banana's ice skating rink! Whether you are a beginner or a seasoned skater everyone enjoys a spin around our Ice Rink. Afterwards let's jump back on the bus and head to the beautiful Coffs Harbour Jetty Foreshores to enjoy lunch, the park facilities and the beach! No swimming today.

Thursday 10th January: Recycle day – Float your boat. The children will be in centre making boats out of recycled materials today, then putting them to test to see how they float or if they sink. Please bring in some materials to be recycled such as milk bottles, soda bottles, tissue boxes etc.

Friday 11th January: today we are off to Dorrigo National Park to explore nature! We will be doing the 'walk with birds boardwalk' and having our lunch at 'the Glade' picnic area, followed by some group games and activities.

Monday 14th January: A morning out on the beautiful Bellinger River canoeing with Bellingen Canoe Adventures. We will be having our lunch there before heading back to the centre. Please pack a hat and a spare set of clothes.

Tuesday 15th January: off to the Big Banana Water Park today for a whole lot of fun on the water slides. Afterwards, lunch and a play at the Jetty Foreshores Park. Please pack swimmers and a rash shirt, a towel, hat, lunch and water bottle.

Wednesday 16th January: sensory day will be in centre getting messy with slime and play dough making, experimenting with shaving foam, making moon sand and much more!

Thursday 17th January: to celebrate International Kid Inventors' Day we will be holding an invention convention in centre where the children can invent and create anything they can imagine.

Friday 18th January: Urunga Foreshores today for the Giinagay Aboriginal Learning Program with Ranger Jess. The program offers syllabus linked learning through interactive activities with strong cultural and environmental messages. The children will enjoy cooking bush food, arts and crafts, and games, dance and song.

Monday 21st January: Lasertag today at the Big Banana- Enter the alien world that is Area 351!!! Strap on your Gen7 Supernova Battlesuit vest and phaser. Then it is off into the arena, dimly lit with fog swirling - you think you are in a Star Wars set! Watch out for the opposition players and the interactive targets hidden throughout the arena - zap them before they get you! The thumping sound track, spectacular light show and vibrant laser beams. Sun Safety: No Hat, No Play (or play in the shade).
