



Food Nutritious foods are essential for growing, playing and learning. Clothing Guidelines Clothing Guidelines bring swimmers or change of clothes in Summer months. Children are encouraged to wear comfortable casual clothing, (midriff or singlet tops are not recommended) when attending Vacation Care. We ask that children wear covered shoes. (Thongs, slip-ons, high heels, strapless shoes; etc. are considered unsafe)
